Lawn Replacements



Ready to replace some lawn? The plants listed below are able to take up the slack with due to vigorous growth and tolerance to different conditions. We recommend you not mix too many together in the same area, as they will compete. Keep weeds down while the groundcover establishes. Once established, a successful lawn replacement will only require periodic light weeding and shaping, resulting in less mowing and more wildlife appeal.

- Aaronsbeard St. Johnswort** – *Hypericum calycinum*
- Blue Rug Juniper** – *Juniperus horizontalis 'Wiltonii'*
- Russian Arborvitae** – *Microbiota decussata*
- Gro Lo Sumac** – *Rhus aromatica 'Gro Lo'*
- Korean Arborvitae** – *Thuja koreaiensis 'Glauca Prostrata'*

SHRUBS FOR SHADE

- Euonymous** – *Euonymous fortunei*
- Sweet Box** – *Sarcococca hookeriana var. humilis*
- Spreading Yew** – *Taxus repandens*
