Street Trees



Trees that are suitable for street plantings must have several qualities. First, good street trees are relatively "clean" - this means they don't drop large amounts of fruit, pollen, frass (aphid excretion) or twigs. Some prefer street trees to have a columnar, pyramidal or vase-shaped habit to make them easier space. They typically are no more than 40 feet tall, have good fall color or ornamental value, and do not have surface-lying roots. Finally, a street tree must have tolerance to heat, drought, wind and pollution.
